A REFLECTION

<u>Christmas Day</u> Jesus was born - the Lord came down to earth. To all He brought the Good News of God's Peace.

<u>Palm Sunday</u> Jesus was greeted by the crowds who waved palm branches and shouted "Hosanna to the King".

<u>Maundy Thursday</u> At the Last Supper Jesus knelt and. washed the feet of his disciples as a sign of friendship, as a sign of service to others. Jesus gave himself in the gifts of bread and. wine - for the feast so that all could eat, so that all could rejoice.
