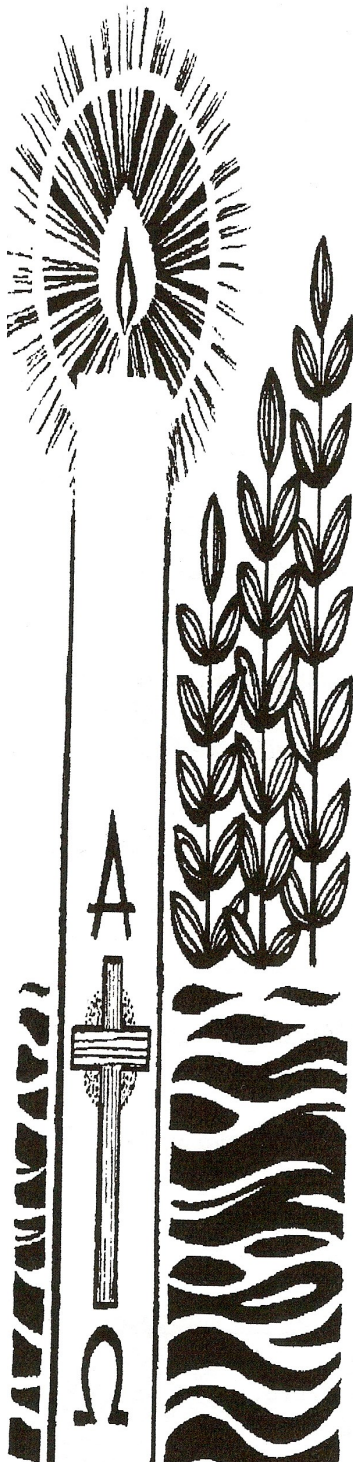

Additional Guidance

- ✚ A Baptism is both a Parish and a family occasion, a time for rejoicing. Keep things simple so that we do not lose sight of the *deep spiritual significance* of your child's baptism. Your child will share in the life of the Church through the Holy Trinity - Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- ✚ In this Parish, Baptism is normally celebrated on a Sunday morning at 12.00pm or during the 10.30am Mass.
- ✚ One of your child's names must be a Christian name i.e. a Saint's name. We depend upon our Saint to protect and guide us during our lives.
- ✚ At least one of the Godparents must be a Catholic and at least 16 years of age. It is important that they are a baptised Catholic, living out their Catholic faith to the full. (Additional friends or family members may act as witnesses).
- ✚ If you live outside St. John Vianney Parish and you wish your child to be baptised here, written consent must be obtained from the Parish Priest of the Parish you presently live within.
- ✚ It is the custom of St. John Vianney to provide the baptism candle and certificate, but you will need to bring a white garment/shawl for your child.
- ✚ If there are any problems, please do not hesitate to ask. We will be happy to help where we can.

It is the custom to give a donation to the Priest or Deacon who officiates at the Baptism.
